This training should be attended by anyone who works with children, youth, persons with disabilities or older adults. This training has applications for clergy, church staff, lay-persons, preschool staff, childcare providers, foster parents, healthcare providers, nursing home staff, home healthcare aids, beauticians/cosmetologists and professionals and volunteers who work with children, youth, older adults and persons with disabilities.

This training will focus on understanding Mandated Reporting: what, when and how to report; signs and indications of child abuse and neglect, and abuse of older adults and persons with disabilities; and the necessity for having a mandated reporting policy in place for churches, daycare & preschool facilities, and other settings where staff may come into contact with victims of child abuse and abuse of older adults and persons with disabilities. This training will provide information on child abuse and neglect, domestic violence, sexual assault, abuse and neglect of older adults and persons with disabilities and available resources. This event will help fulfill the training requirements that have been mandated for beauticians and cosmetologists. This presentation is part of the Family Violence Coordinating Council's continuing effort to educate and enhance services provided by our community partners and to provide training that will improve practices and support efforts to increase victim and community safety.

Presenters will represent the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS); S.A.F.E.(Sexual Assault and Family Emergencies); SWAN (Stopping Women Abuse Now); Centralia City Schools Home to School Liaison; Adult Protective Services and Regional Ombudsman; and Institutional Insurance Professionals. There will be time at the end of the program for questions and answers.
