In the late 1800's, Simon Greenleaf came to faith in Christ as an attorney. He subsequently wrote a book "Testimony of the Evangelists". It is written from the perspective of an attorney who took the Biblical record and discovered the validity of the person of Jesus and that He was who He said He was beyond a reasonable doubt and came to faith in Christ because of such

In the mid-1900's, C.S. Lewis came to faith in Christ as a philosopher. He looked at the logical implications of the claims of Christ and said that it made no other sense than to trust Jesus. *Mere Christianity*, presents his claims and conversion.

In the late 1900's, Lee Strobel came to faith in Christ as a journalist. He looked at the story of Jesus and discerned that He either Lord or an outright liar. Studying the accounts of the Biblical and extra-Biblical records, he concluded that Jesus was who He said He was. *The Case For Christ* and *The Case For Faith*, are written by Lee and available in adult and teen editions.
