Spring Training Work Days for Disaster Relief Volunteers

On **Saturday, April 5** there will be two events, one at **Blackhawk Baptist Camp** and another at **Grace Baptist Church in Kansas City, MO.**

On **Saturday, April 19** a third training and work day will be held at **Lake Springfield Baptist Camp.**

All three of these events will include "hands-on" training with the use of disaster relief equipment: chain saws, water pumps and other tools. In addition, the day will include latest information on readiness for disaster response, team identification, responsibilities, group building and how we are organized to respond.

At our two camps we will help do spring clean up while we are training. In Kansas City we will cut down dead trees on the church grounds. Dress for physical work, wear steel toe shoes if you have them and bring work gloves. Complimentary lunch will be served at all three events. The day begins at 9:00 a.m. in Kansas City and at 9:30 a.m. at Blackhawk and Springfield.
