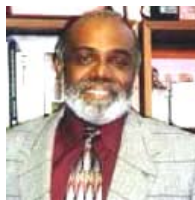

Five families, or about 25 people, have attended worship and other events at the church. Pictured is the youth choir singing a song for “peace in our land” and the She Sho Group choir singing about “loving our neighbors.” The Karen have been in refu-



gee camps in Thailand for over 20 years. This community of Karen are recent arrivals in the U.S. -- some have come within the last several weeks. Jewish Vocational Services is the resettlement agency for them here in Kansas City. Grace Baptist Mission Committee has joined with JVS to befriend and mentor the Karen. We are learning from each other and enjoying the Spirit at work in our midst. The connection with the Karen began almost 200 years ago when missionary Adoniram Judson went to Burma and evangelized the Karen
