



## Application for GRR Mission Grant

GRR grants for 2019 are offered to encourage and empower GRR churches to make God's mission their passion in new ways.

These are matching grants that can be used by GRR churches for just about any **new** ministry (activity, event, project) directed toward those outside the church. It may be an activity in the surrounding community or something halfway around the world. But it must engage the members of the applying church (i.e.: the grant money is not to send to someone else).

This is how it works:

The church designs a **new** ministry that is focused on people not regularly associated with the church. That effort might be a program over several weeks or a single event. Be creative as you look at the needs around you. Show the cost of the mission project/activity in your regular budget for 2019. Based on the merit of the proposal and the availability of funds, GRR will award a matching grant (up to a maximum of \$1500) to the church for enhancing the financial support of new mission initiatives.

*For example, the church may commit to start a food pantry, an after-school tutoring program, or a senior adult activity time. It might be a mission project in another state or even out of the USA. However, the ministry must be **NEW** and focused on needs **OUTSIDE THE CHURCH** and **ENGAGE THE MEMBERS OF THE CHURCH**. The church budgets \$3000 to cover the costs of the program. If approved by the Region, the church will receive \$1500. (If the church had budgeted \$500, they would be eligible for \$250; if the church had budgeted \$9000, they would still be eligible for only \$1500).*

**Who may apply for grants?** Any GRR church in good standing. "Good standing" is evidenced by (1) a current annual report on file in the Regional office and (2) having contributed to the financial support of the Region, either through United Mission, America for Christ, or Specifics during **2018**. Priority will be given to churches that have not received a grant previously.

**What is the deadline?** Application may be made at any time during 2019. As long as funds last, approved projects will receive grants.

**What are the limitations?** There are only three qualifications. The mission activity/project must be **NEW** and its focus must be on those **OUTSIDE THE CHURCH** and it must **ENGAGE CHURCH MEMBERS**.

## What do we do?

1. *Prayerfully discern how God is calling your church into mission.*
2. *Prepare a brief written description of the proposed effort and have it approved by the church. Include the funding in the 2019 church budget.*
3. *Submit the **application** to GRR including:*
  - a. *The **cover sheet** with signatures of the Pastor and Moderator.*
  - b. *A short (1-2 pages) **explanation of the mission activity/project.***
  - c. *A copy of the **2018 church budget** as approved by the church (or evidence of other church action authorizing the expenditure). Please identify the budget lines associated with the mission grant project.*
4. *The Region will review the proposal and make awards based on merit and the availability of funds. Notice of award will be made as soon as possible.*
5. *When the mission project concludes, please send a brief evaluation of your experience, including the benefits to the church and the things you learned to the Region.*
